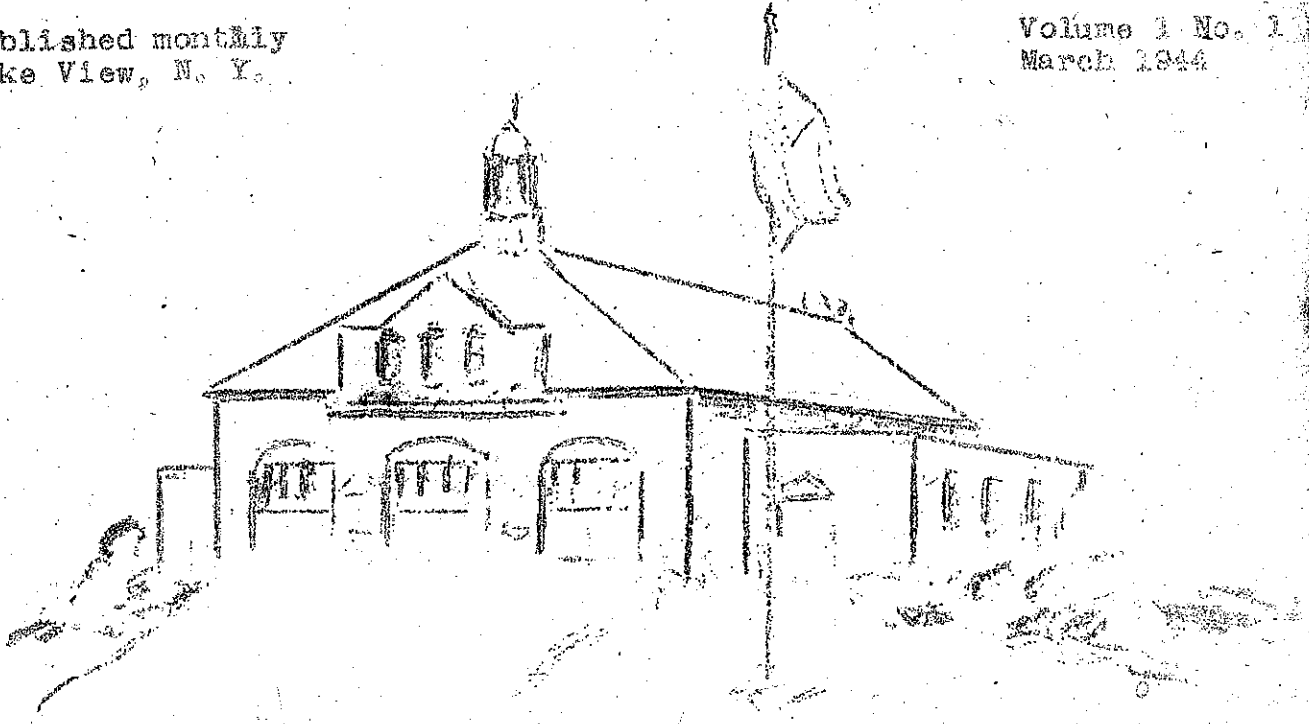


LAKE VIEW LOCAL
